Dear Members,

We wish to inform you of the most recent updates to Section 10: Training Endorsement Workshop, in the IBOC *Certification and Examinations Handbook*.

After the successful online TEW held in May, we realized that there was some ambiguity in how various candidates and sponsors interpreted the requirements for the teaching segment in the TEW.

We draw your attention to Point 10.5. Note especially that the teaching preparation requirements are now described as follows:

SECTION 10 – Training Endorsement Workshop

10.5.3 Participants are required to prepare the following:

- 1. An outline of a schedule of what they are teaching in a TA module. It is based on TA theory of the participant's own or other author's material which would be suitable for a beginning or advanced TA training group. The schedule will describe the flow of a half day / full day training.
- 2. A section from the above named schedule used to demonstrate their teaching style. The candidate will have a maximum of 20 minutes to engage the group in learning through a process that is congruent with the candidate's approach as an adult educator. Staff will provide feedback on the effectiveness of the candidate's teaching style.
- 3. A handout relating to the content of the teaching piece which can be shared online with the audience as didactic support.

We believe that this brings both clarity in what is needed and invites candidates to consider how they best demonstrate their role as adult educators.
